

Use the clues below to match a number to a continent. Write the number inside the continent on the map that matches the clue.

<u>crosses</u> this continent.






The Equator <u>crosses</u>

Prime Meridian.


The Equator <u>crosses</u>

also <u>crosses</u> it.






This continent is <u>north</u>
