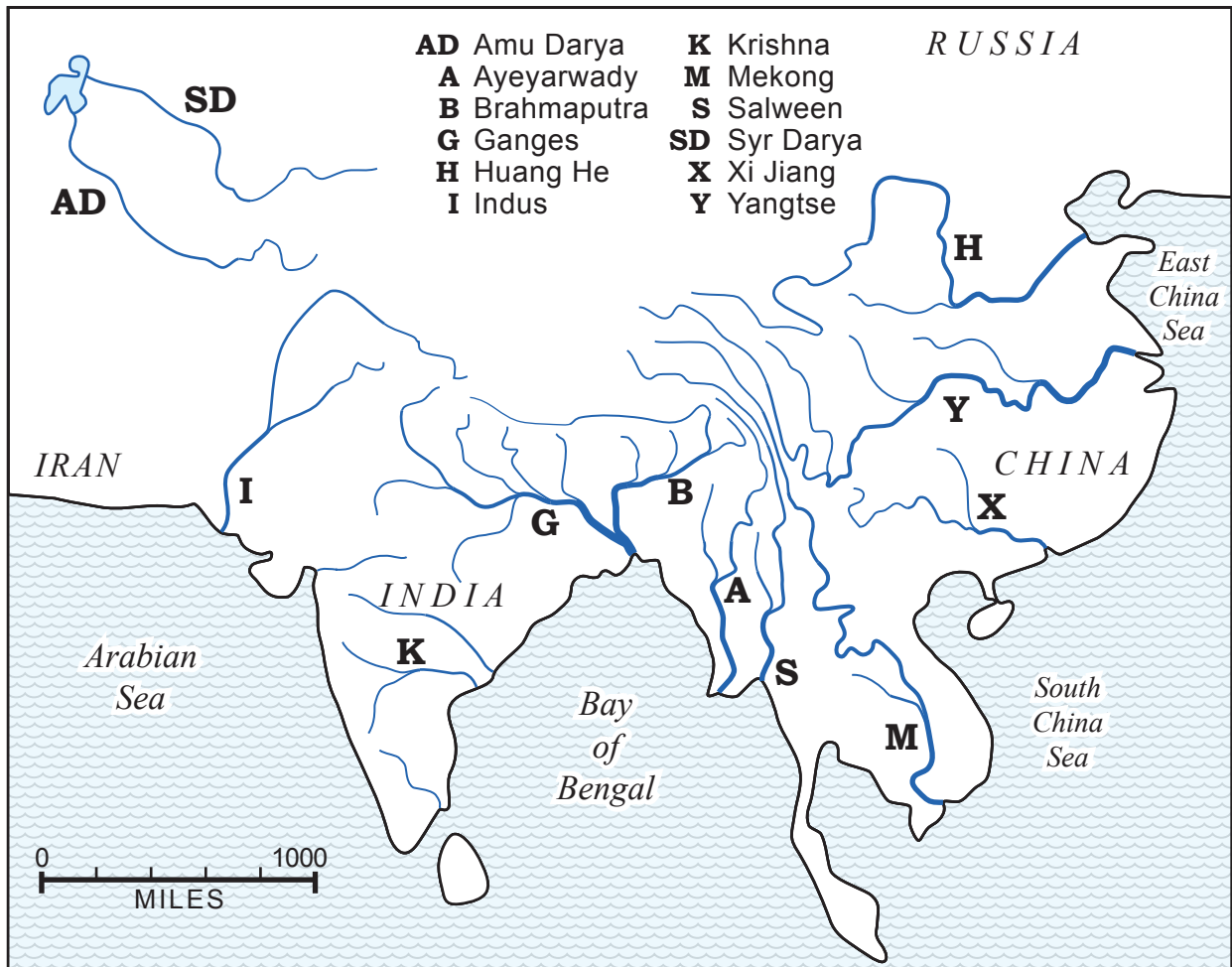


Rivers of Southeast Asia
